Section XII Nominating Committee

2. **Two (2) change to 1** the members shall be active ruling elders designated by the session, one of whom will serve as chair of the committee.

5. **Five (5) change to 3** of the members, not persons currently serving as officers, shall be nominated and elected at the annual meeting of the congregation.

**9. The floor shall be open for nominations for ruling elder positions at the special meeting of the Congregation in July change to November.**

No other business may come before the Congregation.
