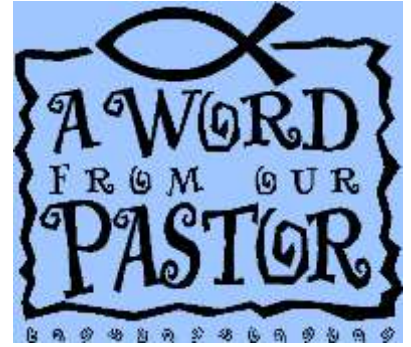

Dear Congregation of First Presbyterian of Delhi,

By now, you have heard that Pastor Lisa will be retiring after Easter. As your Session, we want you to know that we are praying for Pastor Lisa and for First Pres as we start the next chapters in our book of life. A luncheon is being planned to send Pastor Lisa off with our best wishes for her retirement. Details to follow.

Pastor Lisa's last day in the pulpit will be April 17, 2022, Easter Sunday. Her official retirement date is May 15, 2022. Following that, she will have two weeks paid leave by First Pres and two weeks covered by SusValley Presbytery COM. The COM has a pastoral care fund to help in situations like this.

There will be a special congregational meeting in the second half of March, moderated by COM, to dissolve our pastoral relationship with Pastor Lisa. The exact date will be relayed as soon as we have it.

As always, if you have any questions or concerns, please reach out to one of us. Please continue to pray for our church as we prepare to embark on the journey of the future. Open your hearts and minds to the ideas of change and new possibilities. Embrace this opportunity to grow with Christ.

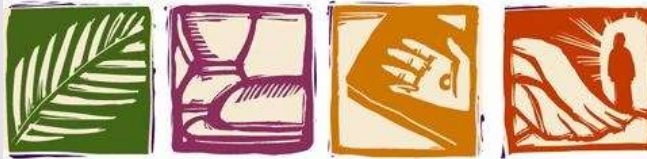

In the month of April our mission will be focused on Church World Service hygiene kits. Betty Bell is currently working on assembling these kits. These kits are given out to individuals and families all over the world when they have a need from disaster or poverty situations.
