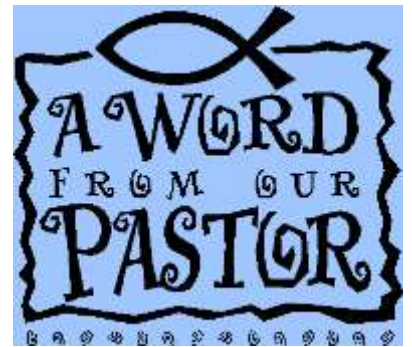

We have been talking about love, but I guess we are always talking about love or sin. After all, sin is about how our love becomes weird. Oh, yes, there is confession also because once we have become weird, we need a path back.

Think back about your life for a moment, would you. When have you met love—just plain old, innocent love? How did love effect you? Was the moment beautiful? Was it exciting? Was it quiet, like sitting in the sun late in the afternoon hearing the crickets and watching tree tops bending in the breeze? When have you known love?

I remembered being new in town, a brand new five-year old first grader. I was at school—a never before experience for me. I knew I did not belong there. It was not like I belonged somewhere else. I was just there and it was all a mystery.

I recognized several of the children from the neighborhood. So, the moment was not so foreign, if you know what I mean. It was time to go out to play. A huge weeping willow tree dominated the corner of the play yard. It was like the tree in my backyard. I was jumping trying to catch a branch that was just out of reach. A classmate started jumping next to me laughing. We both came down to earth and she said, "It looks like fun. I hope it is OK for me to join you?"

Yes, it was OK. Jumping with another person trying to catch a low hanging willow branch was definitely OK. I mean, this was not romantic love or life changing love, but it was an exuberant moment in a small child's life sharing exuberance with another. I realized that these other strange children were not so strange after all.

Before long, a third, then a fourth, then other jumpers were bouncing with the two of us in the corner of the school yard. There was love. Simple, uncomplicated, beautiful, exuberant childhood love of life and jumping and trees. Looking back, I can see this was a sweet moment for us all. The first play period of the first day at the first grade of school was strange for all of us. But some of us shared this moment and it was good. Somehow we all knew that life would be possible for us.

When I went home after school, my mother asked me the inevitable question. She asked me what I learned. I said, I learn that all of us liked to jump as high as we could. She was confused. I was encouraged. She was happy I was encouraged. Love again.

I am still encouraged by the thought that just maybe life is possible in all its stages. You see, God loved you then, God loves you now and God will love you in that life that is forever. "Love is born of God." So jump with a friend however you jump these days. God loves you.

PNC Progress Report

The PNC has been working closely with Dr. Greg Garis, Executive Presbyter for Transformation to produce a video that can be posted on several media sites. TRUSTEE MEETING HIGHLIGHTS FOR JULY - AUGUST 2024

- Regular FPC bills for July and August have been reviewed, approved and paid.
- The annual inspection of all fire extinguishers has been completed by Action Fire Co.
- Little Inspirations preschool had to install fencing in back yard due to insurance requirements for child care facilities.
- Oil and Gas pre-buy contracts have been secured for winter heating season.
- Investment committee has researched interest rates for CDs and savings accounts and best rates were offered by Morgan Stanley. Opened one savings account and one Certificate of Deposit to increase interest income.
- Trustees are always taking care of maintenance projects throughout Church and manse, i.e. toilets in CE wing, mold on walls in Boyd Hall, doors that need adjustments to be ADA compliant, etc. Special thanks to Joe Cantwell and all trustees that keep Church maintained and safe.

Apportionment



The **Per Capita amount for 2024** has been set at **\$45.90 per member**. Per Capita apportionment is based on church membership as of December 31, 2022. Our apportionment is based on 151 members giving a total of \$6,930.90. The money is paid by our church to cover our share of basic operation costs of our Presbytery, Synod, and General Assembly. Each member is invited to contribute \$45.90 to help pay this obligation.
