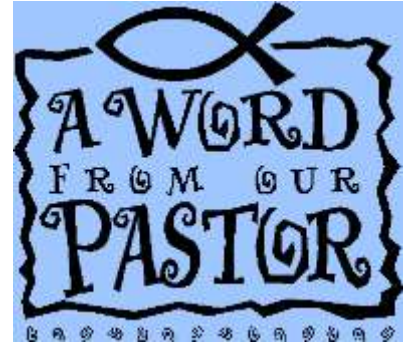

I am sitting in the office looking out the window at the crab apple tree nearly in bloom. Bright Sun. Saturday and Sunday we had a nice rain so everything is even greener than usual. I was wondering what the Bible had to say about springtime. So I looked it up. What I got was, it was the time kings go out to war.

I am not feeling very warlike at the moment. Bessie is with me. She just spent the week with the grandchildren, well two of 3. I went down and spent two days with them. We are getting ready to visit the third grandchild in North Carolina. She is competing in the College National Equestrian Meet. This is a very exciting moment in her life. In short, things are very good with us and I hope they are for you as well.

But this time of year the warmth is more than the sun returning to our part of the world. It is the time of the Resurrection. Jesus is with us as a living presence both healing and leading.

What healing are you a part of? Are there people you know who are lonely or frustrated or anxious? Have you experienced some sort of struggle over the years similar to theirs? Part of the power of the Church family is sitting with others understanding their moment. A burden shared is a burden halved. I know this is an old and common piece of wisdom. It is old and common, however, because it is true. Jesus has brought the right people into your life over the years. Is it your turn to be the right person for someone else you know? Whether you realize it or not, you have brought healing to others in the past and will do so in the future.

Jesus is also our Lord. A Lord is a leader, someone who takes people into battle. One of the great falsehoods of American culture today is the notion that stress is to be avoided at all costs. So Christians, like others, tend to avoid the difficult. But surely a moment's reflection on the Crucifixion reminds us that the path to victory is not always comfortable. It has been said that God is more interested in our character than our comfort. If God has placed an important but uncomfortable moment in your life, I pray for you.

Having said that, paraphrasing David in one of his Psalms, I hope the boundaries of your life are falling in pleasant places. In all circumstances God cares about our present as we build a future with him and his people. God is Kind, a Savior and a Lord.

## CWS Personal Care Kits

Our April mission focus is wrapping up. Betty Bell has assembled 177 kits so far and will continue to do more. The kits will be delivered to Oneonta on May 12, but item donations can always be saved for next year. The items included in the kits are:

- 1-gallon re-sealable plastic bags
- Toothbrushes (in original packing)
- Bath-size bars of soap (in original packaging)
- Travel-size deodorant (3.4 oz. or less, non-aerosol)
- Travel-size lotion (3.4 oz. or less, fragrance-free, NEW only)
- Travel-size shampoo (3.4 oz. or less, NEW only)
- Travel-size toothpaste (3.4 oz. or less, expiration date of 1 year)

The Mission Committee will be covering the cost to ship these kits (\$2.00/kit). If you would like to contribute toward that expense, just write "CWS kits" on your donation.

## Apportionment



The **Per Capita amount for 2025** has been set at **\$49.29 per member**. Per Capita apportionment is based on church membership as of December 31, 2023. Our apportionment is based on 123 members giving a total of \$6,062.67. The money is paid by our church to cover our share of basic operation costs of our Presbytery, Synod, and General Assembly. Each member is invited to contribute \$49.29 to help pay this obligation.
