STEWARDSHIP PRAYER: That in gratitude for our gifts, we may grow them and give back with increase.

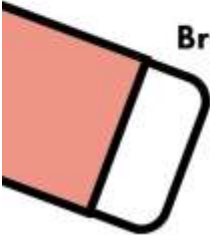
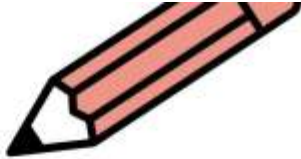
